### ST. MAARTEN at a glance

**Founded:** Settled by Arawak Indians who arrived from South America. The Carib Indians followed later and gave the island the name Soualiga, or “Land of Salt.”

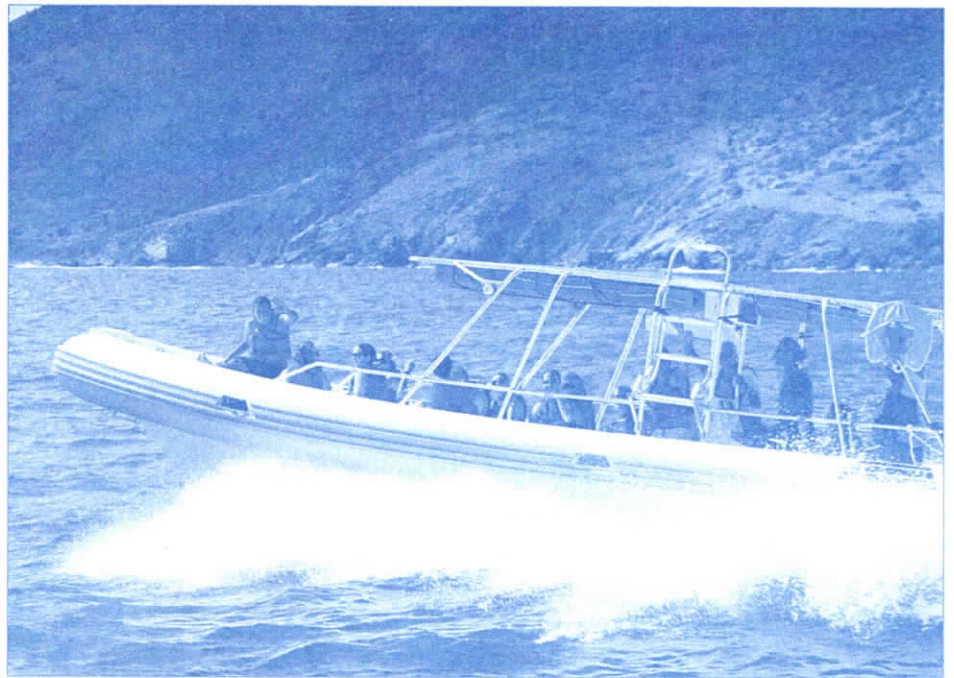
**Region:** Located in the northeastern Caribbean, the land is divided 60/40 between the French (St. Martin) and Dutch (St. Maarten), although the Dutch side has a larger population.

**Population:** 74,852 (est. 2007) – 38,927 living on the Dutch side and 35,925 on the French side.

**Climate:** The area enjoys dry, warm temperatures averaging 82°F. Rainstorms pass quickly, and the sun shines almost every day.

**Language:** On St. Maarten, the official language is Dutch; however, most locals speak English. The residents of St. Martin speak English as well; although, French is occasionally spoken.

**Currency:** The guilder (NFL) is the official currency on the Dutch side, while the Euro (EUR) is used on the French side. The U.S. Dollar (USD) is accepted throughout the island.

# ST. MAARTEN

## Two worlds, one spectacular island

---

Measuring only 12 miles from north to south, this treasured isle is home to two nations. Divided between the Netherlands and France, the Dutch side boasts casinos, high-rise luxury resorts, and non-stop activity while the French side is known for naturist beaches, chic boutiques, and hotels. Together, they add up to a memorable vacation.

### A long history

Traces of Stone Age settlements have been found around the island that date back to 4,000 B.C. Inhabited by the Arawaks between 800 B.C. and 300 B.C. followed by the cannibalistic Caribs, it was the Tainos who greeted Columbus when he arrived in 1493. However, the island's real history began with French and Dutch settlers who divided the island in 1648 and have lived side-by-side ever since. St. Maarten, governed by the Netherlands Antilles until 2010, is now a constituent country of the Kingdom of the Netherlands (along with Aruba, Curacao and the Netherlands), while St. Martin is part of the French West Indies.

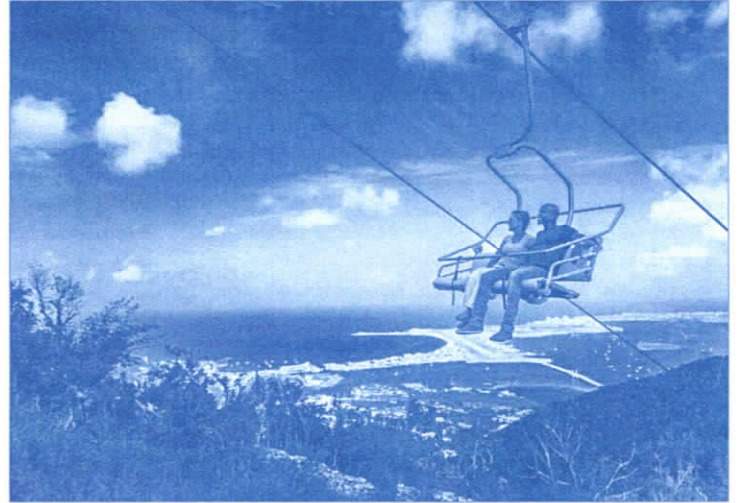
Get to know the dynamic duo of Dutch and French St. Maarten with a sightseeing tour that begins in the Dutch capital of Philipsburg and travels through the countryside towards the Dutch/French border, with only a monument indicating that you've entered another country. Look out for the spectacular views of Orient Beach, nearby Pinel Island, and St. Barth's. Marigot, the capital of French St. Martin, is a charming enclave of gingerbread houses, classic bistros, and bustling outdoor markets.

### Discover St. Maarten's splash zones

Blessed with warm crystal clear waters, white sand beaches, and endless sunshine St. Maarten is a Caribbean play land waiting to share its treasures with you.

Take a walk on the bottom of the Caribbean Sea courtesy of a specially designed Sea Trek diving helmet. Or soak up the views from water level as you paddle across the largest saltwater lagoon in the Antilles on a guided kayak expedition expedition; the spectacular scenery and serene pace makes this a wonderful way to explore the island.

Feel the wind in your sails on exhilarating sea-going adventures such as a leisurely cruise aboard the luxurious Golden Eagle catamaran.

### Back on terra firma

Make the most of your tropical experience as you bask in the sun and discover an island filled with plenty of activities.

Discover St. Maarten's cultural history at the Emilio Wilson Museum. Tucked inside Rockland Estate, a traditional plantation house built in the 1700s, the museum offers visitors the opportunity to learn the local tale of Trace Wilson, who was born into slavery on the estate in 1818. His descendant Emilio Wilson purchased the property and converted it to a cultural and educational center aimed at teaching current and future generations about plantation life and the customs and heritage off St. Maarten, "The Friendly Island."

Take in breathtaking views from the Sky Explorer chairlift. The star attraction at the Rockland Estate, this four-person aerial chairlift takes visitors on a 25-minute scenic ride up 3,000 feet of cable to one of St. Maarten's highest mountain points, Sentry Hill. From the 1,125 feet vantage point, you're treated to 360-degree views of the whole island, lovely tropical scenery and ocean views.

Saddle up and explore the island's natural flora and fauna on the back of a sure-footed horse. Your adventure includes riding along scenic rocky trails and a chance to ride your mount right into the waves of the Caribbean Sea for a memorable swim.

Whether you prefer activities fast and furious or slow and steady, St. Maarten offers surprises around every corner. What more could you ask for while on vacation?





# DID YOU KNOW?

## Local cuisine

With over 300 restaurants on the island, you have your choice of everything from European to Asian to American restaurants. And make sure you stop in to one of the island's "lolos," small restaurants or stands that specialize in the local and Creole cuisine of the island. One of the most popular drinks is the fruity, rum-based liquor that's made with guavaberry.

## Rockland Estate Eco-Park

Adventurous travelers shouldn't miss an opportunity to surf down the mountainside in a huge inner tube or soar above a canopy of lush trees 1,125 feet off the ground on the Sentry Hill Zip Line.

## What's in a name?

In the 14th century, Carib Indians named the island Soualiga, which means "Salt Island" for the large mineral deposits that dot the island; in fact, the remains of the Great Salt Pond can still be seen in Philipsburg.

## Size doesn't matter

At 37 miles in circumference, St. Maarten/St. Martin is the smallest island in the world divided between two sovereign powers.

## See-worthy

The views from Lookout Point in Marigot are truly panoramic. Perched atop Cole Bay Hill you can look out at Cay Bay, Cole Bay, Simpson Bay, and the beautiful blue Caribbean Sea.

## Shop 'til you drop

Shopping on St. Maarten and St. Martin offers high quality duty-free shops. Marigot on the French side and Phillipsburg on the Dutch side offer clothes, cigars, jewelry and liquor at steep discounts.

## In the swim

The waters around the island remain comfortable for swimming year round with summer temps averaging 83°F and 79°F in winter.

## To the point

Rising 1,391 feet, Paradis Peak is the highest point on the island.

## Seaside luxury

St. Maarten is the top destination for the impressive yachts of the super-rich; in fact, there are several 300-foot-long ships moored in the luxurious marinas.

## Vaarrooom!

Due to the unique proximity of low flying airliners, the Princess Juliana International Airport is one of the few places in the world where aircraft can be viewed in their flight path just outside the end of the runway. Thrill to the sight of watching airplanes land and take off from the comfort of a multi-deck oceangoing vessel.

## Can you hear me now?

When you make a phone call from one side of the island to another, you pay long distance charges since it is routed through international systems at least several islands away.

## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

**Shore Excursions:** Guests will meet at a specific location for each shore excursion departure. Please refer to your shore excursion tour ticket for the correct place and time. Your Shore Excursion staff or our Tour Operator will be at that location to assist you. It's recommended that you drink bottled water while in port.

**Docking:** Your Princess ship docks at the A.C. Wathey pier, the main pier for cruise ships on the Dutch side of the island.

**Transportation:** The center of Philipsburg is about a mile from the ship. Taxis are available at Cyrus Wathey Square. Taxis are not metered and rates are determined by the government. Confirm fare before departing. Water taxis are also popular. Tickets are sold at the end of the pier.

**Beaches:** Philipsburg is located on the white sands of Great Bay Beach. Orient Beach on the French side is featured on beach break tours SXM-285 and SXM-290. Note: Portions of Orient Bay are clothing optional; partial nudity may be encountered.

**Shopping:** Best buys are on the Dutch side. Front Street in Philipsburg is lined with jewelry and watch stores selling at duty-free prices.

**Tipping:** Suggested tipping is 10 to 15 percent for good service.

**Banks:** Normally open 8:30am to 3:30pm Monday through Friday.

**Post Office:** Generally open 7:30am to 5:00pm Monday through Thursday. Friday hours are 7:30am to 4:30pm.

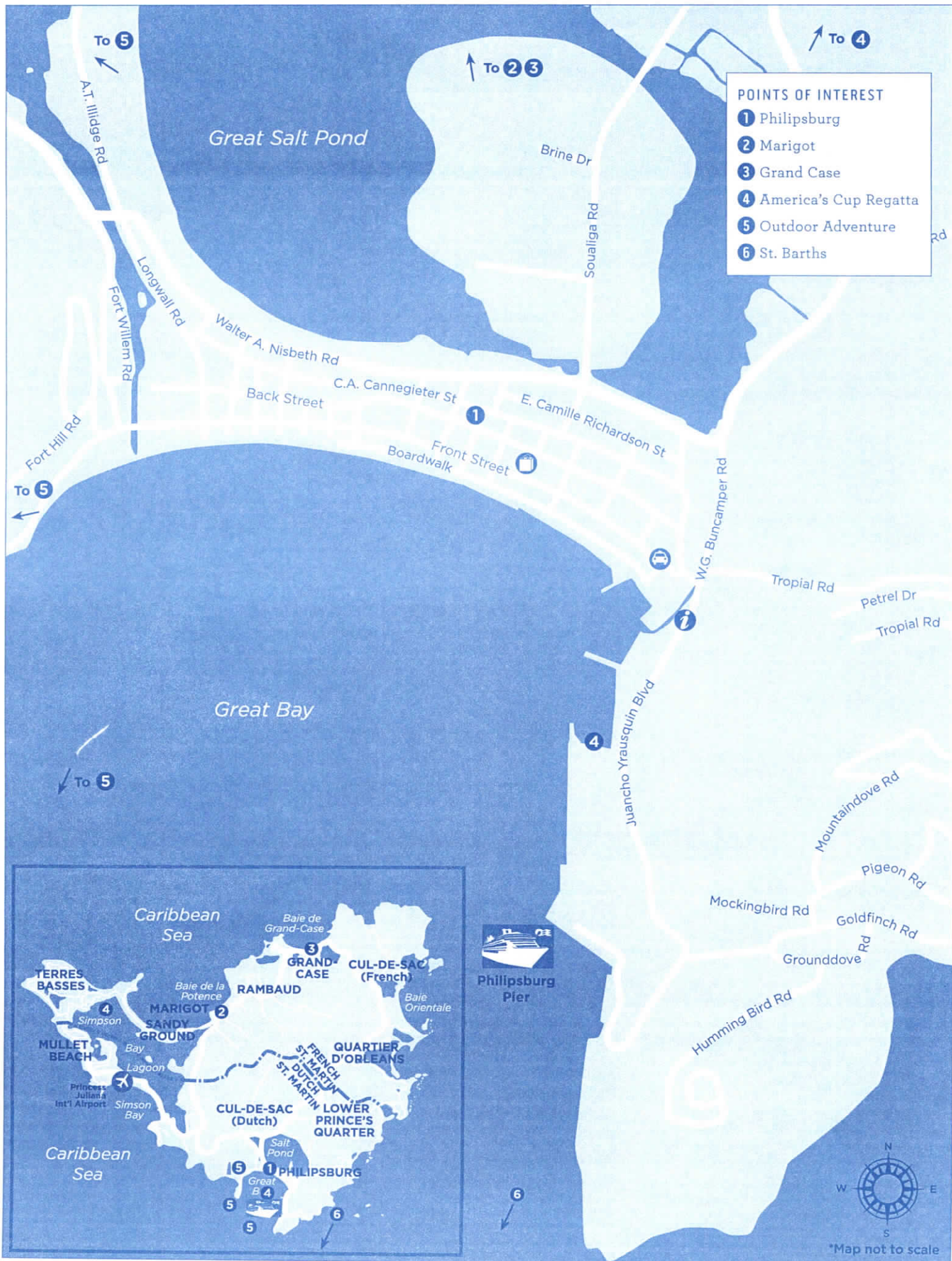

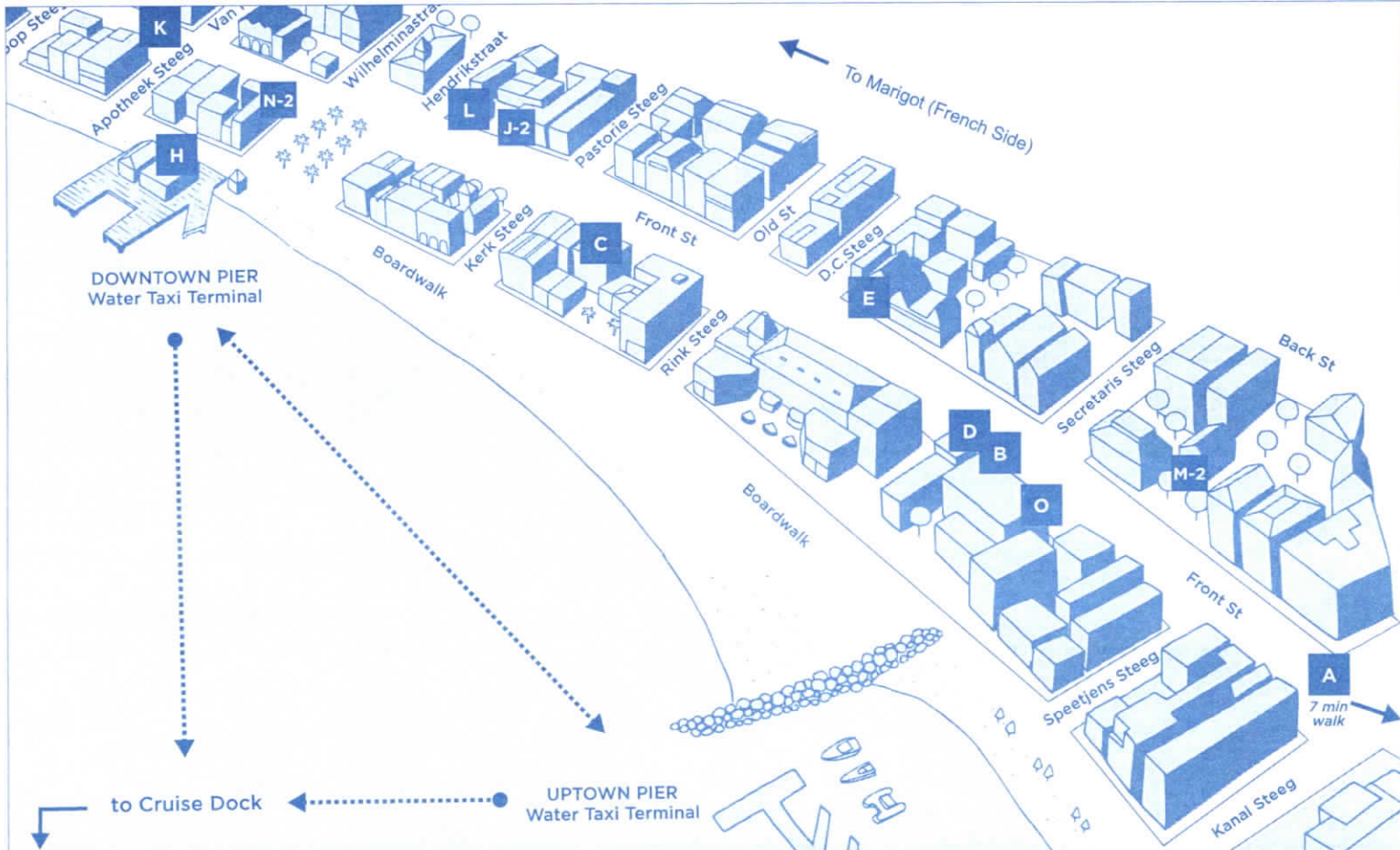

Soon, you'll stop at Marigot to browse the outdoor food market, inviting sidewalk cafés and an array of duty-free shops. Your next stop is Carousel in Simpson Bay, enjoy a ride on the famous Venetian Carousel, stroll through tropical garden as you view photo gallery. You have the option to purchase authentic Italian gelato ice cream from a variety of flavors. Great photos are yours at Lookout Point, which overlooks neighboring islands and the beautiful blue Caribbean Sea. Your tour ends back in Philipsburg. Board your air-conditioned transportation and proceed through the Dutch capital of Philipsburg, a bustling town with historical buildings, lovely street activity and an abundance of shops and cafés. Along the way to Marigot on the French side of the island, you'll pass the Great Salt Pond followed by a photo stop at Cole Bay Hill. The tour proceeds through Cole Bay Village passing the unassuming border monument, and continue into the French capital of Marigot. Here, you can browse the outdoor food market, inviting sidewalk cafés and an array of duty-free shops. Note the quaint and colorful Colonial-Creole architecture as you travel through the seaside towns of Grand Case and the French Quarter. Finally, you'll return to the ship in Dutch St. Maarten.

Board your air-conditioned transportation at the dock for a 30-minute, air-conditioned ride to Rockland Estate. You will be guided to the plantation house, built in the 1700s, to learn the powerful story of Trace Wilson, born into slavery on the estate in 1818 and his descendant Emilio Wilson who purchased the property to educate current and future generations about the conditions of plantation life as well as the customs, traditions and history of St. Maarten, "The Friendly Island." After a brief orientation, embark the Soualiga Sky Explorer for the approximately 25-minute ride to the top of Sentry Hill, St. Maarten's highest elevation at 1,125 feet. A series of platforms encircle the mountaintop show casing 360-degree views of the whole island including vistas of neighboring islands Saba, St. Eustatius, St. Barts and Anguilla. When you are ready to descend simply board the Soualiga Sky Explorer for the scenic trip down the mountain. Enjoy exploring the Estate. When you are ready to depart board air-conditioned shuttle back to your ship.
